Subject: Administrative Modification FY26-06 to the 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)

Background

The Valdosta-Lowndes Metropolitan Planning Organization (VLMPO) has updated the 2050 Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) to incorporate the Safety Performance Management (PM1) Targets established by the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) in accordance with federal requirements under 23 CFR 490.

This administrative modification reflects VLMPO's support of GDOT's statewide safety targets for the performance period ending December 31, 2026, as follows:

- **Number of Fatalities:** Maintain traffic fatalities under the projected 1,574.
- **Rate of Fatalities per 100 million VMT:** Maintain the rate under 1.245.
- **Number of Serious Injuries:** Maintain serious injuries under the projected 8,103.
- **Rate of Serious Injuries per 100 million VMT:** Maintain the rate under 6.408.
- **Number of Non-Motorized Fatalities and Serious Injuries:** Maintain under the projected 1,312.

Key Notes

This modification updates the 2050 MTP to incorporate the Safety Performance Management Targets established by GDOT, ensuring consistency with federal requirements and statewide safety goals.
